Today's Topic: Luminary Lighting Instructions

Editor's Introduction

The information that follows was provided to Garry Fasick by Rachel Andreoli.

Garry serves as the CARC contact person as we take a turn at lighting the 400 luminaries that outline Children's Lake.

Rachel has a leadership role in the organization that "owns" the Luminary Lighting Event.

The purpose of posting this document as a CARC ***How Do I...*** is to help ensure that the information will be accessible to any of the CARC Luminary Lighting Volunteers who might need this type of information on short notice.

Let's begin...

Hi, all! Thank you for volunteering to help light the luminaries this year. Feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns. My cell is 717-343-6073.

Please set up a meeting time and place and notify your group. Also, butane lighters are provided but you may want to bring a few of your own.

Instructions for your lighting night:

1. PICK UP CANDLES

- Darlene & John Benoit (contact # 484-798-9272) will have the candles ready for you by noon. Please pick them up no later than 4 p.m. on the side porch of 217 Front St.

The candles will be on a bench on the 3rd St. side of the house. Follow the sidewalk next to the light pole and the dogwood tree.

Please return all items here.

2. REMOVE, REPLACE & LIGHT CANDLES

- Remove the remains of any old candles (even if they don't look used), place in trash bags provided.
- Replace with a new candle (make sure the candles are centered and stable or they can melt the jars)
- Light candles

3. CANDLES TO LIGHT

- From the home on Front St. around the north wall, TCO and along the whole east side of the lake
 - At the memorial board on the back side of the sign by the AT office
 - Walking path, Humpback bridge and Walking bridge on Bucher Hill Rd.
 - Along the south end to the boat dry docks
 - The Bubble behind the Tavern (there is a separate bag of candles marked for these jars)
- Do not light jars on private homeowner's properties. They light their own.**

4. RETURN ALL ITEMS

- All used and extra candles, bags and lighters are to be returned to the Benoit's porch. See Step #1 of details of this location.

- Please leave no trash or other items behind. There are trash cans at both ends of the lake for your personal trash.

Thank you again for helping to continue this beautiful tradition for yet another year. This community spirit is one of the reasons our town is such a wonderful place to live.
