- The Events Calendar View offers me a pro a nice style and format in which to present the information to our readers.
- The Google Calendar offers me two pros ease of setting up and maintaining events, especially the type of events that recur throughout the year. And a nice monthly view that many club members like.

Going forward, any events that recur on a weekly or daily basis will be housed in the *Google Calendar* but not in *The Events Calendar View*.

Instead, a new menu item called **Things To-Do >> Frequently Recurring Events** will capture a single instance of content for each event that used to appear in *The Events Calendar View* as many as 52 times per year. The Editor's job has been simplified. Thank you for your understanding.
